#### **EARLY YEARS**

Our Early Years provision closely mirrors, and is, based on Ministry of Education curriculum. In addition, we aim to encourage children to develop positive attitude to learning.

#### PRIMARY SCHOOL

The primary school curriculum is specified by the Ministry of Education. It draws from English, Mathematics, Science, History/Geography, Technology, Arts and Physical Education.

#### SECONDARY SCHOOL

The secondary curriculum is as specified by the Ministry of Education. In addition, it covers the specifications of WAEC, NECO and NABTEB examination boards.

#### TERTIARY SCHOOL/DEPARTMENT

The tertiary curriculum is as specified by NABTEB. This includes NABTEB General Education (GCE O' Level), the National Certificate and the Advanced National Certificate.

#### NABTEB GENERAL EDUCATION CERTIFICATE

NABTEB **General Education Certificate** is closely aligned to the WAEC/NECO specifications.

### NABTEB ANBC AND ANTC COURSES

The available subjects for the NABTEB ANBC and ANTC examination include Advanced Mathematics, Advanced Computer Craft, Advanced Economics, Advanced Financial Accounting, Advanced Business Management, Advanced English, Advanced Biology, Advanced Chemistry, Advanced Mathematics and Advanced Physics.

Note: - Candidates for NABTEB A'LEVEL shall register for 3 A' Level subjects depending on the intended course of study in the university. Being a standard

examination, NABTEB result is not accessible online, but it is printed in hard copy.

NABTEB Advanced National Certificate level (ANBC and ANTC) programme is an alternative Advanced level programme established to provide candidates with the opportunity to acquire practical knowledge and an alternative route to further their careers in various higher institutions of learning in Nigeria and foreign universities. Thus, a Candidate with NABTEB ANBC or ANTC certificate is qualified for 200 level admission into the University.

The NABTEB Advanced Level Programme is a national examination equivalent to IJMB, JUPEB and CAMBRIDGE. NABTEB A' LEVEL, like any other Advanced Level examination, allows students to secure admission into 200 Level in the University through Direct Entry. NABTEB Advanced Level Examinations include ANBC and ANTC.

Note: - Candidates for NABTEB A' LEVEL shall register for 3 A' Level subjects depending on the intended course of study in the university. Being a standard examination, NABTEB result is not accessible online, but it is printed in hard copy.

#### PERIOD OF EXAMINATION

The NABTEB A'LEVEL is conducted once a year in Nov/Dec. The result is released after 90 days to meet admission requirements at various Universities.

#### NABTEB FEE & REGISTRATION

#### **APPLICATION FEE**

Application fee for NABTEB is N20,000

#### **CLEARANCE & ACCEPTANCE FEE**

The acceptance fee is N50,000. The acceptance fee is to be paid within one-two weeks after the completion of registration to enable applicant to print their admission letter into their selected study centre. #### **TUITION FEE**

Winners Academy regulates NABTEB fees and its cheap and affordable. The fees are affordable compared to other NABTEB study Centre with extremely high fees. Current fees one hundred thousand naira (₹150,000) which can be paid in instalments.

#### **OTHER COSTS**

Tuition fees does not cover other cost of running the programme such as Accommodation fee, Examination fee, Laboratory/Practical fee, textbook, etc. In this regard, students are required to pay for these charges separately as some of these fees are optional.

Stated below are breakdown of the fee applicants are meant to pay during the period of the programme.

### **Hostel Accommodation (Optional):**

This fee varies between N90,000 to N120,000 depending on the location of the study centre, how suitable the room is and the total number of occupants in the room.

Note: - Payment covers the whole period of the programme and this fee is optional which means applicant can decide whether to book a hostel accommodation with their study centre.

# **Laboratory Fee (Science):**

The laboratory fee is only applicable to science students, and it varies in prices between N15,000 to N30,000 depending on the course combination of the student. This laboratory practical will be conducted towards the end of the programme before the NABTEB final Examination.

CONCENTRIC INTERNATIONAL SCHOOL (CIS) PRE-DEGREE ADMISSION FORM FOR 2023/2024 ACADEMIC SESSION.

The Tertiary Department of Concentric International School (CIS) has been accredited by NABTEB to offer their NABTEB General Education (GCE O' Level) and NABTEB Advanced National Certificate (ANBC and ANTC).

The NABTEB General Education Certificate is equivalent to WAEC/NECO GCE O' Level/School Certificate. Passes in the examination is accepted for 100 level admission to Nigerian and overseas universities.

The year-long programme NABTEB General Education (GCE O' Level) component aims to prepare candidates for O' Level exams and the UTME to enhance their chances of admission into 100 level degree programmes at any university. Candidates need credits in at least three subjects to apply. The course will offer subjects from Mathematics to Accounting. Upon successful completion, students can transition to related faculties. The programme costs N120,000 and is located at Oye Ekiti Campus in Ekiti State.

As for NABTEB Advanced ANBC and ANTC certificates, these are equivalent to IJMB, JUPEB and CAMBRIDGE 'A' levels and, therefore, are accepted for direct entry/200 level admission to Nigerian and overseas universities.

The school has opened applications for these Programmes for the 2023/2024 academic session.

# Eligibility and Admission Requirements

To qualify for the NABTEB General Education O' Level programme, candidates must have completed secondary education and earned credits in at least three subjects in Senior Secondary Certificate Examination, GCE or NECO.

# The Transition to 100 Level

For a smooth transition to 100 Level, candidates are required to sit for the UTME and achieve the minimum JAMB Cut Off Mark for the University Admission. They must also comply with the University Screening Test as prescribed.

All candidates with deficiencies in their O' Level results must register for NATBEC GCE O Level, WAEC or NECO, and pass all the relevant deficient subjects.
